Last-minute getaways

If you're looking for a last-minute getaway for the holidays, you might pursue a retreat that will give you a Rocky Mountain high. Historic Hotels of the Rockies is making 20 member lodges — from luxurious bed and breakfasts to city hotels and rustic ranch resorts — available. The lodges are in [Colorado](#), Montana, Wyoming, New Mexico and South Dakota, and are offering packages that include accommodations, special menus and seasonal events.

For example, lodging begins as low as \$219 a night, double occupancy, at the Hotel Colorado (www.hotelcolorado.com), which is less than a three-hour drive from Denver. For \$399, couples can stay two nights at the Historic Elk Mountain Hotel (www.elkmountainhotel.com) in southeast Wyoming, 7,300 feet above sea level, where they can have Christmas Eve dinner, Christmas Day lunch, afternoon tea and breakfast. In Fort Benton, Mont., the Grand Union Hotel's (www.grandunionhotel.com) New Year's Eve Gala offers a package starting at \$290 per couple and includes a five-course gourmet dinner, dancing, champagne toast and breakfast on New Year's Day.
